Frontline Arts, formerly known as the Printmaking Center of New Jersey, is a 501c3 non-profit arts organization serving the entire state of New Jersey and larger Eastern United States through our in-house and mobile programming. Our home base is located in the center of New Jersey, in a three-story fully equipped print and papermaking studio with administrative offices and a newly renovated gallery.

Incorporated in 1974, Frontline Arts offers groundbreaking mobile print and papermaking programs and events alongside high-quality classes, studio services, and communal space with shared equipment for the print and papermaking communities.

We work on the front-lines of artmaking to serve thousands of artists, Veterans, youth, community groups, and the general public each year.

We served **877** people through paid services and programming, and we served **3,899** people through free participation in our Veterans' Papermaking Program--*Frontline Paper*--and through exhibitions and community events.



We connect and build communities through socially engaging arts practices rooted in papermaking and printmaking.



## Highlights this year:

- Frontline Arts and the Printmaking Center of New Jersey **combined assets and liabilities** to finalize an assumption agreement between the two groups, officially completed **March 31, 2018**
- The organization **updated their mission, vision, and bylaws**
- We purchased and implemented **new software systems** for membership, fundraising, website maintenance, and credit card processing
- We **launched Paper Connects**, a spinoff of the mobile arts educational program Roving Press, in March 2018
- We not only maintained, but we **grew our membership** numbers and offer new levels now (**122 Members** at end-of-fiscal year)
- We have fully merged **Frontline Paper** into our **flagship program**, our national Veterans' papermaking initiative started under the PCNJ roof in 2011

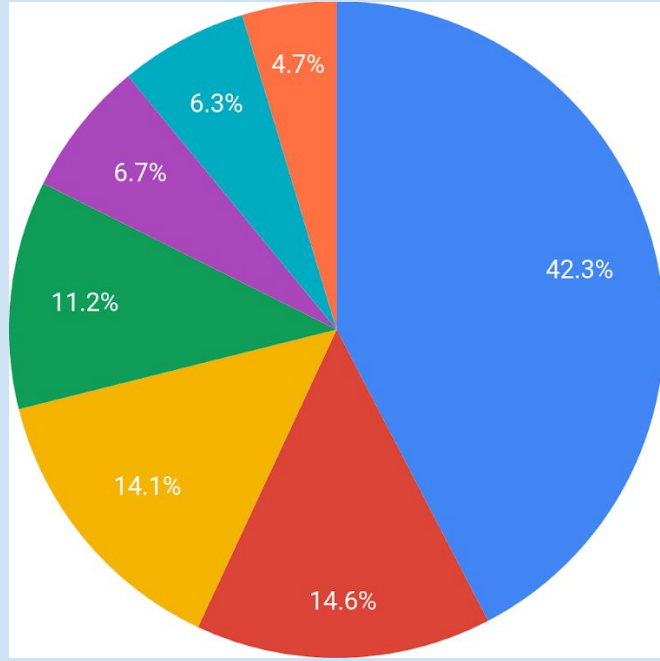

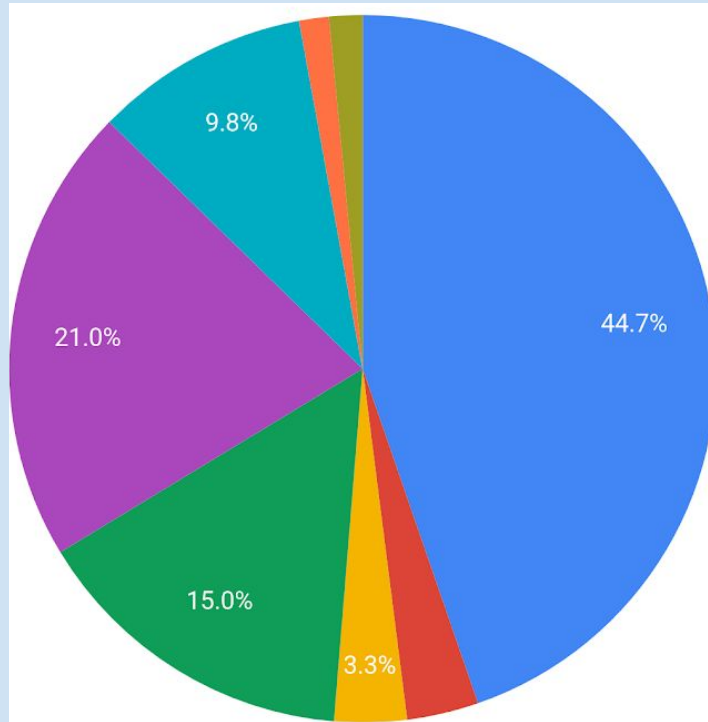

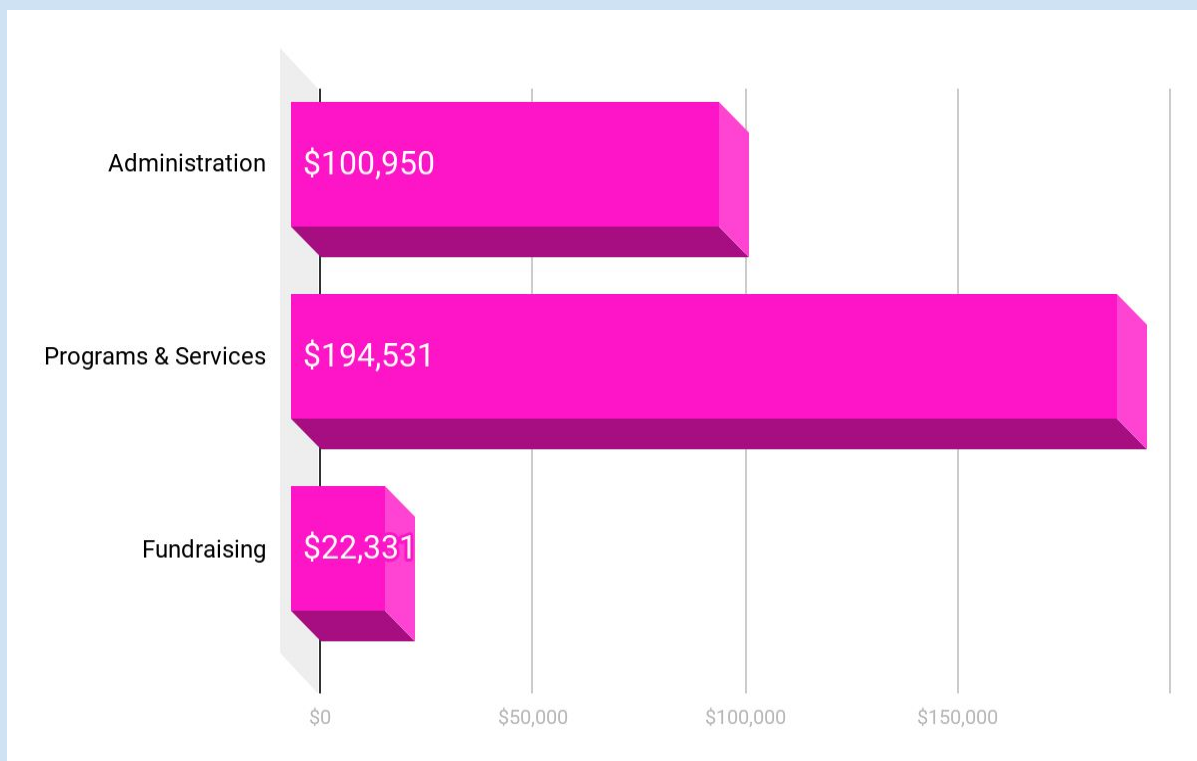
