





INDIVIDUALS SERVED

INDIVIDUALS SERVED IN FISCAL YEAR 2023 = 2,593

1,895 Adults were served via live programming, including Artists, Veterans, and the general public. **698 Youth** were served, under the age of 18, along with an additional **99,439 virtual impressions for adult and youth.** We spported **193** individuals through paid services and programming, and served **1,746** through free participation in the Frontline Paper Veteran Program. Lastly, we served **2,094** by free exhibitions, community events, online video tutorials and livestreams.

HIGHLIGHTS

In Fiscal Year 2023 Frontline Arts achieved significant milestones, including multiple exhibitions, a highly successful season of adult education classes, and numerous free community events. In January, we onboarded five new culturally-diverse board members who contribute fresh perspectives in programming. The completion of major building upgrades was a noteworthy accomplishment, encompassing a full restroom renovation and the installation of brand-new seating in our main studio.

We also expanded the Scrubs Paper Project to East Jersey Old Town Village as well as Middlesex County at First Responder's Day. Our commitment to youth engagement was evident with the highest number of workshops since FY19, reaching nearly 700 youth across 8 workshops statewide. Additionally, we conducted impactful workshop facilitator trainings and listening sessions, coupled with professional development in collaboration with a local healthcare marketing group.
